
### DIRECTIONS TO O'BRIEN'S

### From Pennsylvania Turnpike

Take Valley Forge exit
Get on 202 South and continue to West Chester area
Take 2<sup>nd</sup> West Chester exit (PA Route 3/West Chester Pike)
End of exit ramp, left onto Route 3 towards West Chester
Right at first traffic light (McDonalds) on Montgomery Ave.
Left at next light onto Marshall Street
Right at first stop sign onto Church Street
Left onto Ashbridge Street
Second right onto Hoopes Park Lane. Look for MG signs.
Next right (100 ft.) onto Locust Lane
Straight ahead into O'Brien's driveway

#### From I-95

Take US322 exit and follow to West Chester area
Count traffic lights from US322–202
Do NOT take West Chester by-pass...go straight into town on High St.
Left onto Marshall St. at traffic light (this is #10 after 322–202)
Right at first stop sign onto Church Street
Left onto Ashbridge Street
Second right onto Hoopes Park Lane. Look for MG signs.
Next right (100 ft.) onto Locust Lane
Straight ahead into O'Brien's driveway


